1 – Restoration workshop - musée du Quai Branly – Jacques Chirac

The Musée du quai Branly – Jacques Chirac is a museum featuring the indigenous art and cultures of Africa, Asia, Oceania, and the Americas. The museum collection has 450,000 objects, of which 3,500 are on display at any given time, in both permanent and temporary thematic exhibits. It is located in the 7th arrondissement of Paris, France, along the Seine river and at the foot of the Eiffel tower.

Three 45 minutes visits will be held at the musée du quai Branly - Jacques Chirac, at the times indicated below. The visit will include the conservation laboratory, and a small fraction of the permanent exhibit: this short walk will focus on a few showcases in which are presented the objects made of skin, in order to illustrate the variety of the museum's collections. At the end of the visit, the participants will benefit from a free access to the permanent collections and temporary exhibitions: rare and prestigious objects in *Oceania*, and presentation of the rich cultural life of the collector Félix Fénéon.
